The matter was listed for hearing today before this Authority. The Complainant(s) and Ld. Counsel for respondent has brought to the notice of the Authority that both the parties have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding on 9th February,2020 according to which the respondent has agreed to refund a total amount of Rs. Forty Two Lakhs, thirty one thousand, one hundred and six (Rs. 42,31,106/-) which includes the interest amount of Rs. Six lakhs, fifty five thousand, one hundred and seven (Rs.6,55,107/-) The complainant vide e-mail dated 12th February,2021 addressed to this Authorityhas intimated regarding the aforesaid MOU and has requested this Authority to decide the matter in view of the compromise arrived between the contesting parties. The contents of the mail are as under:-



"To Hon'ble Chairman RERA, Himachal Pradesh

Sir,

First of all I am grateful to HP, RERA for facilitating this compromise between the two of us which was not happening, otherwise.

Looking to the difficult time posed by the present pandemic we have mutually agreed to settle this issue amicably by accepting the refund in installments over a period of 6 months by way of post-dated cheques as enumerated in the MOU attached to this mail.

Hereby I, request RERA to make this MOU between the 2 parties incorporated in your final order and allow us the liberty to approach RERA in case of non-fulfillment of the conditions with regards to honoring of the post-dated cheques.

I am sending an attachment a copy of the MOU and withdrawal of the complaint No. HIM/P/HPRERA/Complaint-1447, HPRERA/OFL/2020-03 against M/s Rajdeep and Co.

This Authority after undergoing the contents of the memorandum of understanding dated 9th February, 2021, is fully satisfied that the present complaint has been agreed to be settled amicably between both the parties upon reaching to a compromise and the respondent(s) have agreed to refund the entire amount with interest. We have directed the Complainant to file an application before this Authority regarding the compromise in shape of memorandum of understanding so that the compromise decree can be passed



by this Authority. The said application has been filed before this Authority, which stands placed on record. As per the contents of the copy of the aforesaid MOU, it has been specified at page 1 at point no.3 &4, "Considering the personal reasons of the Second party, the First Party agrees to refund the booking amount with Bank interest and without any deductions to the Second Party in the following manner as mutually agreed between the parties
